



Video Production Internship Positions

General: The Ze' deM Media Internship program is designed to offer hands-on experience for college students that are seeking a career in the Media and Communications industries.

Ze' deM Media is a Larnaca based company offering video production and editing services. The interns working for the company mainly focus on the production of a collection of short documentary style videos for KiprosTV. A video based website aiming to support the Arts & Culture of Cyprus. This internship will help develop your practical skills as well as the ability to work in a team environment and making creative decisions that will influence the final outcome of the video.

Eligibility: You must be registered as a Junior, Senior, or Graduate Student in good standing at an accredited college or university. The registration must apply for the full duration of the internship.

Responsibilities: Assist the director to create videos through camera operation as well as by helping in setting up lights in studio and location environments. Other responsibilities include the signing of release forms from contributors and other people who appear in our videos, research and other production management duties.

Qualifications: The selected students who will receive this internship should have a passion for documentaries and/or television. Some background in basic camera operation either through college classes or other experiences is essential. The video production interns should have good interpersonal skills, be organized and team players with a positive attitude. They must have good judgment, creativity and the ability to work in a fast-paced environment. Being multilingual will be considered an advantage but is not a requirement for the position.
