



Post-Production & Multimedia Internship Positions

General: The Ze' deM Media Internship program is designed to offer hands-on experience for college students that are seeking a career in the Media and Communications industries.

Ze' deM Media is a Larnaca based company offering video production and editing services. The interns working for the company mainly focus on the production of a collection of short documentary style videos for KiprosTV. A video based website aiming to support the Arts & Culture of Cyprus. This internship will help develop your practical, writing and broadcast journalism skills as well as your editorial judgment.

Eligibility: You must be registered as a Junior, Senior, or Graduate Student in good standing at an accredited college or university. The registration must apply for the full duration of the internship.

Responsibilities: Assist the director to create videos through a non-linear editing process. Other duties may include researching for appropriate music tracks, DVD authoring, producing graphics for video or any other multi-media projects according to the interns ability and knowledge for related software, log and capture footage, entering subtitles and organizing/archiving footage.

Qualifications: Selected students should have a passion for documentaries and/or television, hold good interpersonal skills, be organized and team players. They must have good judgment, creativity, an eye for detail and the ability to work in a fast-paced environment. Being multilingual will be considered an advantage but is not a requirement for the position.

- Knowledge of Final Cut Pro and/or Adobe Premiere Pro is essential.
- Knowledge of any of the following software is an advantage but is not a requirement:
Adobe After Effects - DVD Studio Pro – Color – Photoshop - Live Type.
